

ACT® Tessaera™ College Pilot Study

ACT® Tessaera™ is a comprehensive next-generation assessment system designed to measure social and emotional skills. It is rooted in empirical research and makes use of multiple methods to enhance reliability and validity. While initially developed for grades 6-12, ACT recently developed a second version for postsecondary use. Institutions can explore the new version for free as a participant in this pilot study.

Overview

- participants pilot the assessment system during the 2018-2019 academic year
- the assessment tool is low stakes, web based, and unproctored
- a URL can be easily distributed to students during pre-enrollment/ registration, orientation, and First-Year Experience courses
- students can test twice within an academic year to determine development

Requirements

- post-secondary institution
- provide information on your students' demographics, academic achievement, and performance on standardized college entrance exams
- minimum of 300 student participants to receive sortable roster and institution-level reports

You Will Receive

- free assessments for an unlimited number of students
- sortable roster report detailing students' scores
- report describing your students as a whole and how they compare to students at other colleges and universities
