How do I learn about all this?

It is simple to learn about majors related to your occupation of interest; just follow these steps:

1. Go to the following website: <http://www.act.org/wwm/index.html> to explore our World-of-Work Map.
2. The World-of-Work Map consists of 26 career areas in eight regions. Each career area is labeled with a letter of the alphabet and is located within one of the eight regions identified on the outer ring of the map. Select the region that corresponds to the career area you are interested in pursuing.
3. Once you are in a World-of-Work Map region, click the career area of choice. There you will find a list of associated majors.
4. Also, talk to your academic advisor about planning your education for pursuit of your chosen career.
