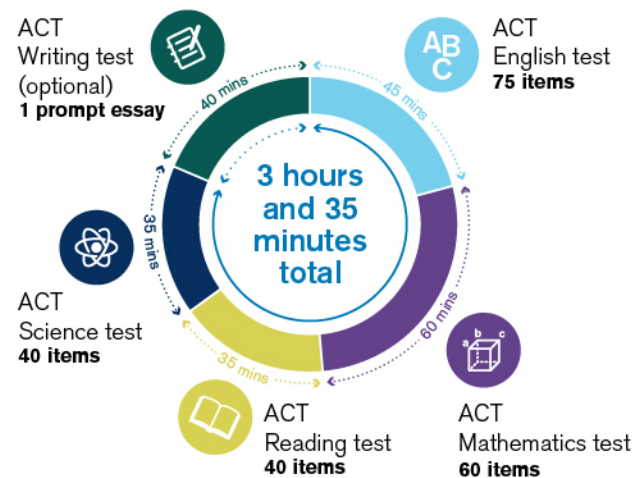
Check our website to see if the university you want to attend requires or recommends a writing test.

The ACT[®] test is:

- A university admissions test required of students by universities around the world when evaluating applicants for their undergraduate programs.
- The university admissions test taken most by the high school graduating class in the United States.
- Accepted for admissions by all four-year universities in the United States, and more than 225 universities around the world.
- Offered at test centers in 140 countries.

Test Content

The ACT consists of multiple-choice questions in English, math, reading, and science. The ACT test takes approximately 3 hours and 35 minutes to complete, including a short break. The ACT offers an optional 40-minute writing test that most international students select.



Why take the ACT

- The ACT is reliable and consistent. Students and universities have relied on ACT scores for more than 50 years to determine how well prepared students are for university courses.
- The ACT is the only university admissions test that offers a science section and score.
- The ACT provides a STEM score to indicate readiness for university courses in science, technology, engineering, and math.
- The ACT Score Report provides recommendations for university majors that fit your interests, abilities, and values.

Your ACT scores

- Your scores can make you eligible for merit-based scholarships.
- Send your scores to up to four universities at no additional cost.
- If taking the ACT test more than once, you select which test date results to send to the schools of your choice.
- Some students choose to take the ACT and the SAT and submit both scores.
