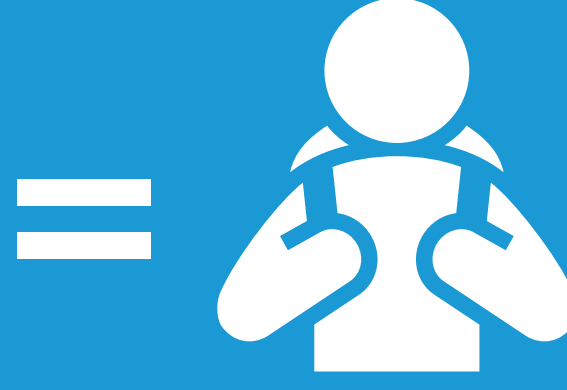

SUPPORT FOR EDUCATORS AND LEARNERS

As of March 21, 2021, the federal government has provided three funding packages worth \$190 billion for K-12 education through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act enacted on March 27, 2020, the Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) enacted on December 27, 2020, and the American Rescue Plan (ARP) enacted on March 11, 2021.

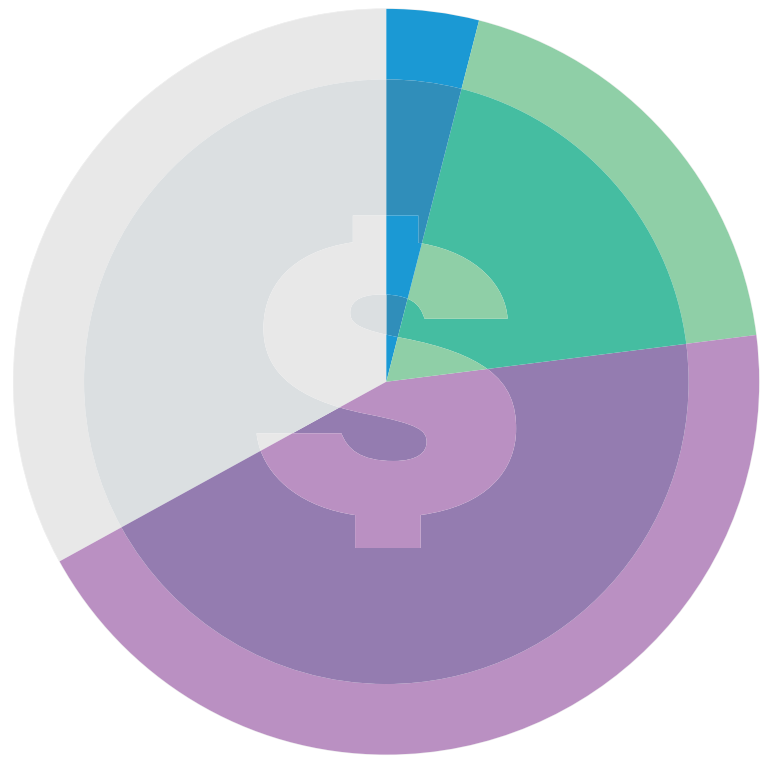

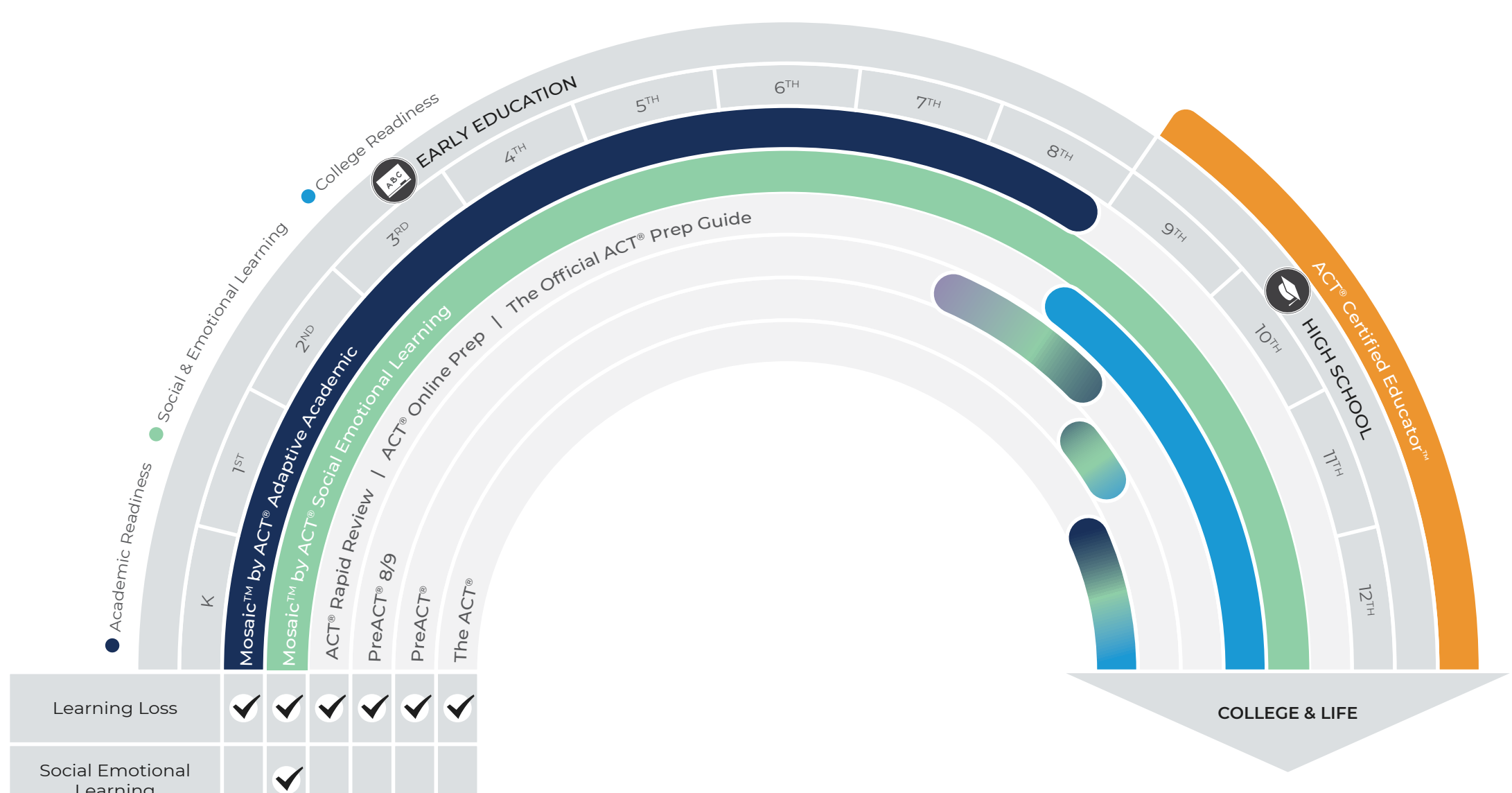
