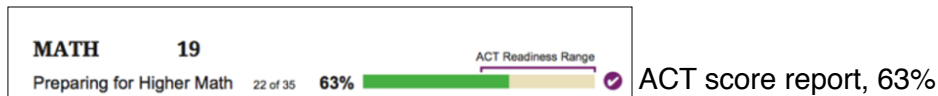


The OpenEd Quick Start Guide for Students

Congratulations on choosing to take the ACT® or PreACT®! Below, you will find instructions on how you can find personalized resources to help you get an even better score. Just have your score report handy, if you have one.

1. In any browser, go to resources.opened.com/act. Please provide an email address and password to sign up.
2. Once you sign up, you will see fields to enter your score for each grading category. Look at your ACT score report and fill in the *percentage* for each category just as it appears on your report. For example:

If you have not taken the ACT or PreACT yet, please check the box that says “Click here if you have not taken the PreACT or ACT yet.”

3. Based on how much practice you need in each of these categories, OpenEd will recommend the best videos, games, and quizzes for you.
4. Feel free to start with whichever subject you want. You can do as many categories as you choose.

5. OpenEd will keep track of which resources you have already used. Videos will appear greyed out if you watched them, but you can always go back and watch them again.
6. Most videos will have a quick quiz suggested after it to check for understanding. Go ahead, give it a try!
7. Likewise, the quizzes are followed by videos for each of the questions you missed. So watch the suggested videos to learn about the questions you got wrong.
8. For any assessments or homework you take, you can see your results under the Mastery tab.
