How to access your NCRC

Step 1: Go to MyWorkKeys.com.

- Step 5: View, print and share your test scores. ACT will not share your information without your authorization. To make your test scores public to employers, select Share Test Score.
- Step 6: View, print and share your certificate. ACT will not share your information without your authorization. To make your certificate public to employers, select Share Certificate.
